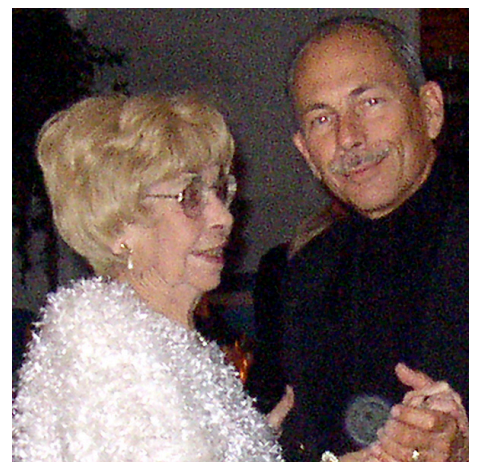

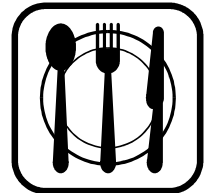

Membership Policy

Dues: There is a \$20 initiation fee, plus annual dues of \$60. The annual dues for new members are prorated at \$5 per month from February to October. If joining in November or December, new members pay the prorated dues for the present year, plus dues for the following year, plus the \$20 initiation fee (\$90 if joining in Nov and \$85 if in Dec). **Renewal fee is \$60 regardless of month paid.**

Membership: Membership privileges extend to member's spouse or significant other, children under 21 residing in the house, and parents residing with the member. Single members pay member rates when bringing a guest to a club event.
