Traveling Croc

According to reports from *AP* and other news sources, an 11 foot, 700 lb American Crocodile was recently captured in Lake Tarpon at Tarpon Springs on the west coast of Florida. What is significant about this capture is the fact that this Croc was born in 1999 near Turkey Point nuclear plant. According to Wildlife officials this is the farthest distance ever recorded for a crocodile to have traveled in Florida, from South Dade to Tarpon Springs north of Tampa on the west coast. Whenever possible, the tails of Crocodiles born in the Turkey Point canal system are marked for future identification. Based on these markings, quite a bit is known about this specific Crocodile. In 2008 it was spotted on the Grey Oaks Country Club golf course in Naples. It was then caught by a licensed trapper and the markings on it's tail were noted. At that time the crocodile was 8 feet 4 inches long. It was then released in the Rookery Bay Reserve south of Naples. A year later, it was again spotted on the Country Club golf course in Naples but no effort was made to trap it. It was next seen on the lawn in a St Petersburg gated community on Tampa Bay. It then moved on to Lake Tarpon in Tarpon Springs. After being captured in Lake Tarpon, the Croc was brought back to South Dade and was released in an area south of Homestead. Based on the past history of this Croc, it is highly probable that it has already begun it trip back to the west coast of Florida.
