From the Editor:

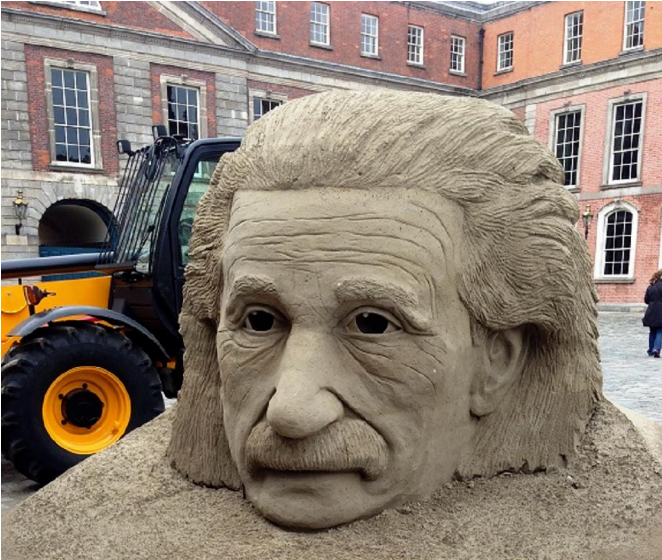
