Monday, November 5, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Commodore George at 7:30 p.m.


- A motion was made by Ted Newlan and seconded by Larry Roesch to accept the minutes of the October meeting as written in the Newsletter.
- Park Manager Steve thanked David and Anna Giuliani for the Black Hawk helicopter appearance at the rib feast event. Steve reminded us that the Classic Car show will be held on February 24, 2008, which is expected to be as successful as last years'. The next job on the docks will be "C" dock, after which the boats will be placed back in the slips where they belong. So far there have been no problems experienced. The Park will host the annual collection of Toys for Tots for needy children again this year, with Pelican Harbor Marina. Toys can be deposited at the Marina office or at the next meeting. They should be unwrapped. Contracts must be renewed and contact information should be updated. Members were wished a Happy Thanksgiving.
- Treasurer's Report: Beginning balance at the end of October 2007 was \$7,366.39 and ending balance at the end of October 2007 was \$5,112.23. 38 Members and 4 guests participated in the trip to Key West to celebrate Fantasy Fest at a total cost of \$3,326.16. Details of the Treasurer's Report will be published in the November 2007 Newsletter.
- Commodore George thanked the Johnsons for putting together a wonderful event at Fantasy Fest.
- There will be a Pig Roast November 10, 2007. Sign up sheets were on each table, and so far, 37 people had signed up to attend. Members whose last names began A-M should bring appetizers, while M-Z should bring deserts. There will be beans, rice, and yucca. The club will have sodas and members

should BYOB. Dinner will be served at 3:00 p.m. at the Pavilion. Bring your appetite and a volunteer was needed for the music.

The December event will be a cruise to Bayfront Park to attend the Boat Parade on December 22nd. There will be live bands, a ferris wheel among other entertainment available. Sign up is requested ASAP. 12 – 15 slips may be available but a fax is needed to the Marina with information on the boats to confirm reservations. The line up for the parade will begin at 5:00 p.m. Members can ride on Bill's boat and there will be a special viewing area. Those not going by boat6 can take metro rail and the people mover to avoid parking problems by Bayside. The theme is "Miami Fantasy – Tourist or Pirate".

- New Business: 2008 Bridge ~ new volunteers for the 2008 bridge reviewed and approved by the Committee. Voting will take place at the December 2007 meeting.
