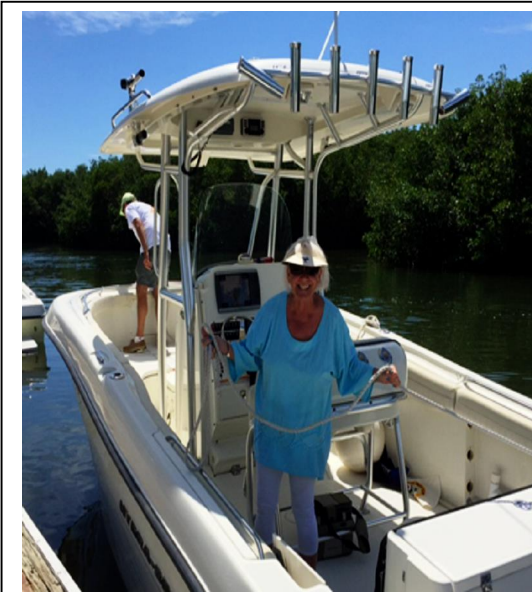

Teresa offered to research for charities with Chip.... Maybe Toys for Tots at the Christmas party. More at next meeting.

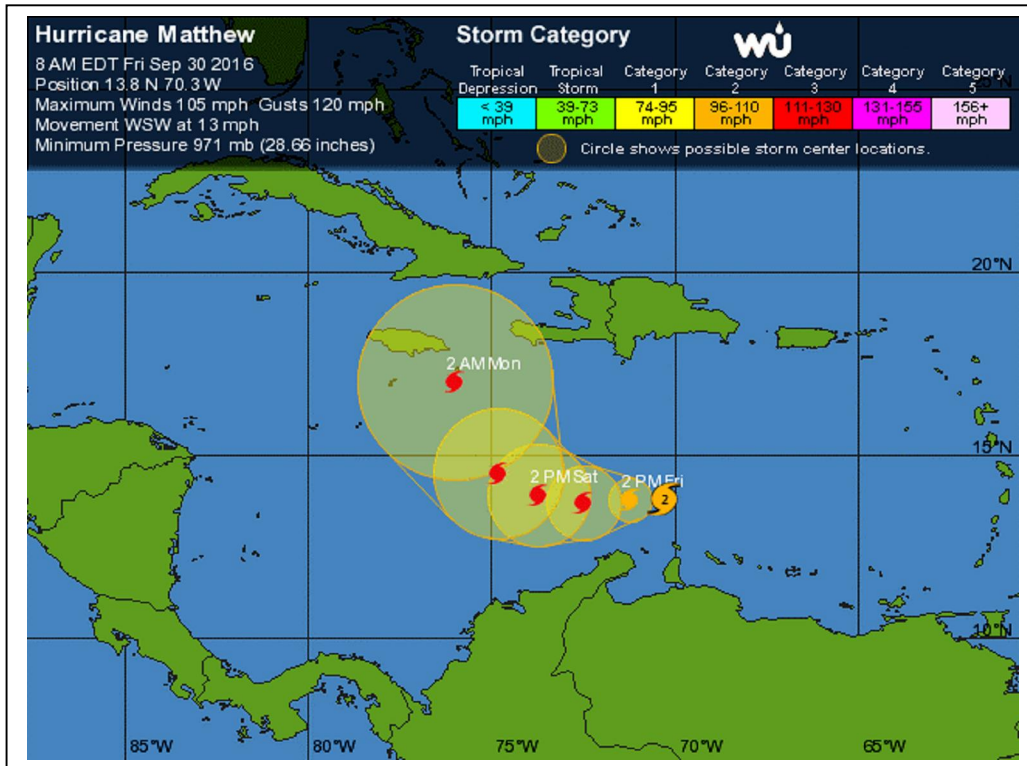
