# FROM YOUR COMMODORE

<u>George Mayer</u> HYC MINUTES OF GENERAL MEETING September 10, 2007

The meeting commenced at 7:30 p.m. with Commodore George Meyer at the helm. A motion was made by Dwayne Powell and seconded by Ken to accept the minutes as written in the newsletter.

**Park News:** Dock master Steve opened by saying that Sonia and Mario Espineira could count on his help if they needed it and knew where to find him. The Fire suppression system is now fully working. In order to use the system, pull all the hose out, open the top valve and the system will come on automatically. There are proposed budget cuts but nothing will change until January 2008 and security of our marina will not be affected. The Pool area in the Park will be closed during the days due to these budget cuts because of a reduction in life guard service and park maintenance. Steve advised that if marina patrons see something in the marina or park that needs attention, we should let him know. Steve apologized to Larry and Sharon Roesch for the loss of their lines. Members were thanked for attending the clean marina celebration. Some markers have been relocated but we can still navigate the channel without incident by staving away from marker # 9 and keeping in the middle of the channel. D-Dock will be done in the next two weeks. The Park is only 9 days behind schedule. C-dock will be moving to D dock and we should be patient as they have only 3 days to move the boats to "C" dock. Don't leave your lines on the pilings when going to "D" dock – take them with you. The entire job should be completed by April 2008. The marina has 40 vacant slips which will fill up quickly. All marina staff have been CPA certified.

Although they were not able to attend, they had made all the arrangements. 7 boats and 35 club members attended dinner. The Club made \$71.00 and this event did not cost the club anything.

October event – Fantasy Fest in Key West. The Club will have a bus and drive all night. There are some changes from last month's review. Bus will depart from Deco Truss at 1:00 p.m. sharp on Saturday afternoon and should arrive in Key West at 4:00 p.m. There are 50 spaces on the bus. If going, get your spot on the bus ASAP. Member cost is \$20.00. The price will go up to \$30.00 for late registrants. There is a cancellation fee of \$40.00. Fee for non-members is \$50.00. Club Treasurer Sharon Roesch will keep an accounting. Prizes will be given for Jokes, Body paint, trivia. All the information will be posted on the web site, in the minutes of the meeting and with e-mails. There will be good food and drink on the bus.

<u>Membership</u>: Dwayne Powell informed there are 57 members. New members Jay and Joyce Cam were not at the meeting. The Hitchcocks received their Club Burgees. Debbie and Bo Justice - Past Members and guests at the meeting were reintroduced.

<u>Rosters</u>: Sandy Zinn said they were still trying to get information updated. There are still maybe 2 members who had incorrect or invalid e-mail addresses but who are not submitting their correct information.

Park Liaison: Buzz Strandhagen said someone hit the ground at Market # 9. One member of the club did over \$4,000 of damage when they moved their boat over in the channel to make way for the coast guard. He advised that we should be careful and don't give way. We can avoid problems by announcing over a loud speaker that we are in the middle of the channel due to "restricted draft" and so cover ourselves.



Ship's Store: Commodore George advised that there was great new stuff on display and encouraged members to make purchases.

Vice Commodore Mario Espineira thanked the members for their support and prayers after the loss of their home due to fire.

**There was a great round of applause for the meal that was served.** 

Sunshine Committee: Jan Meyer advised that August was not a good month for the club. Charlene Powell, Linda Clemons, Stan Scherer and Commodore George all had their share of health issues but are doing fine now. Past Commodore John Troillo (1991 and 1992) passed away in Bradenton Florida. His funeral was attended by original charter members of the club, and a card was mailed out to his wife Connie. Regret was voiced at the loss of Sonia and Mario Espineira's home and they were informed that the members would help in any way they could.

<u>Phone Committee:</u> Susie said everything was fine.

**Web Master:** Larry said everything was fine. All current information on club events etc. could be found on our web page in the front.

**Boat US:** Commodore George advised that HYC has some benefits. Our Group # is GA82404Y. HYC gets half price for membership. Commodore George said if we were interested, he would speak with Boat US to see if we could get speakers for some of our meetings. Salvage rules have changed and we may be able to get someone to talk to us about these changes perhaps at a future meeting.

New Business: Sharon Roesch advised that if members were interested, she would arrange for CPR classes on a Saturday at the Redlands Country Club. A show of hands indicated there was a great deal of interest. Sharon advised that members should check the newsletter and web site for more information in the near future.

50/50: Dwayne Powell won the 50/50.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
